Large Bull Rout Fish, c. 1922

Description:

A rare, fine quality, twentieth century bronze model of a 'Bull Rout Fish' by Albéric Collin (Belgian, 1886 - 1962). This bronze was cast by the lost wax process at the Valsuani foundry, Paris circa 1922. Before casting it was signed and stamped 'Albéric Collin' 'C Valsuani Cire Perdue'. This example has a dark brown patina with lighter reddy brown undertones.

Footnote:

Collin was a prolific sculptor, with a long working life. His early works were cast in Belgium, by the Petermann Foundry, however he soon formed a liaison with the well known French foundry C. Valsuani. A maximum of seven casts were made of each model.
